Proposal for a Linear Park along the Collins Canal on Washington Court was presented to our CPNA Board on 2/16/10

The board reviewed the plan and has asked that the City to set a community meeting to present this plan to the public for comment and review like they would with any CIP project. In this case it is a public works project but there is a major component that needs community input. The plan calls for 22nd Street and Washington Court west of Park Avenue to become one way going west eliminating 2 way traffic. Our board did not feel comfortable with backing that plan without all residents having the ability to see the plan and weigh in on the impact. The Bass Museum is also open and free to Miami Beach residents.

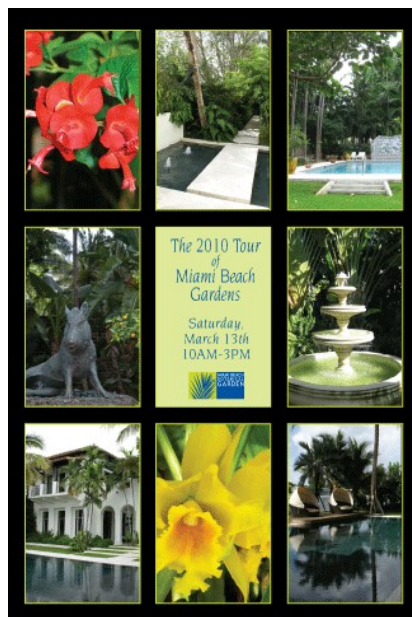
