### **The South Beach local is expanding it's route and adding 2 more Collins Park stops.**

On June 22nd the South Beach Local will be adding 2 more stops, one at 23rd Street and Liberty Avenue across from the CANDO Arts Co-op at Palm Court and another stop at 21st Street and Collins Avenue. These are in addition to the stop currently at 21st Street and Park Avenue. Persistence and ridership support pays off. The buses are scheduled to run every 12 minutes, up from the current 10 minutes. This is a huge benefit to the residents who live between 22nd Street and 25th Street and all those who depend on public transportation to get around the beach. Use it and be happy.

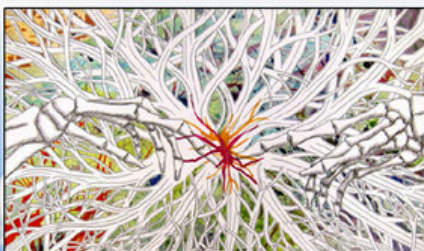
