Middle District Burglaries

On Thursday October 15, between 9:15 am and 2 pm, three homes were burglarized in the Middle District of our city. These burglaries occurred in the 4400 blk. Of North. Michigan Ave., 4500 blk of North Meridian Ave. and the 4700 blk. Of Alton Road.

The homes were unoccupied and Force was used to make entry.

Residents are reminded to be vigilant and utilize proven crime prevention practices, for example;

- Do not leave windows/doors open or unlocked.
- Utilize a monitored alarm system. Activate the alarm whenever you are away, regardless of how soon you plan on returning.
- Trim overgrown foliage that may obscure your home. A home that is obscured, removes the fear of the burglar of being seen by neighbors and passing motorists.
- Install photocell / motion sensor security lighting around the perimeter of your home. Your home should be "Bathed" in a curtain of light.

Many homes that have been targeted did not have these crime prevention measures in place.

We need your help. If you observe any suspicious activity, suspicious people, or suspicious vehicles in your neighborhood, please call the Miami Beach Police Department at 305-673-7901.
